V. APPLICATION SIGNATURE

VII. PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Plans are not required for the following:

1. One or two family dwelling containing not more than 3500 square feet of building area.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the electrical official to be of a minor nature.
3. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

If work being performed is described above, answer Section IV "A. Plans not required."

Plans are required for all other types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal.

PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

Fee Examples:

New House - Permit Cost \$240.00 (Permit Issuance + 3 inspections for Service, Rough, Final + Administrative fee)

Garage - Permit Cost \$185.00 (Permit Issuance + 2 inspections for Rough, Final + Administrative fee)

Service Only - Permit cost \$130.00 (Permit Issuance + 1 inspection + Administrative fee)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL:

Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Hudson Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT:

A permit remains valid for one (1) year from date of issuance. Permits may be renewed. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six (6) months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six (6) months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.

STREET NUMBERS MUST BE POSTED AT ROAD PRIOR TO INSPECTIONS

MINIMUM 3 INCH LETTERS

PERMIT SHOULD BE AVAILABLE ON THE JOB SITE
